Prior to coming to Kellogg Community College also worked as an assessment specialist in the field of substance abuse with his major population being the middle schools, high schools and juvenile center in Calhoun County.

Sedgwick dedicates much of his personal time to the education of kids through his roles as coach and referee for many sporting teams and events. He also remains involved in his own education which began at Southwestern Michigan College where he earned his associate degree, Northwestern Oklahoma State University for a B.A., and Western Michigan University where he earned an M.A. Currently Sedgwick is pursuing his doctorate at the University of Missouri in St. Louis.

In October of 2007 Sedgwick said goodbye to his friends and colleagues at Kellogg Community College as well as in MACRAO as he accepted the position of Vice President of Student Services at Kaskaskia College in Illinois.
